H.E.A.R. Journals

A Simple Guide for Studying Scripture

The acronym H.E.A.R. stands for Highlight, Explain, Apply, Respond. Each of these steps contribute to creating an atmosphere to hear God speak.

<u>Pray:</u> Before starting the day's reading and journal, pray

asking God to speak to you through His Word.

<u>Highlight:</u> As you read the chapter, highlight any verse or

verses that stick out to you. Copy the verse or verse

reference into your H.E.A.R. journal.

Explain: Explain what the text means in your own words.

Some questions you could answer in this section

include:

• How does it fit with the verses before and after it?

Why did the Holy Spirit include this passage in

the book?

What is he intending to communicate through

this text?

<u>Apply:</u> Some questions you could answer in this section:

• How can this help me?

• What does this mean today?

What would the application of this verse look like

in my life?

<u>Respond:</u> Respond to the passage by writing out a call to

action, describing how you will be different because of what you have learned, or writing out a prayer to

God.

Check out the back of this page for some examples of what a H.E.A.R. journal could look like. This system is made to be flexible, so don't stress if your journal doesn't look exactly the same!
