

Link Group Curriculum Guidelines

3D Curriculum

1. **Doctrinally Sound**

All Link Group material is required to conform to certain doctrinal standards. Materials must fall within the statement of faith known as the **Baptist Faith and Message** (<http://www.sbc.net/bfm/>).

2. **Discipleship Focused**

Any curriculum that you choose to use within your Link Group must be focused toward helping group members grow in their love for God, love for one another, and their love for those who do not have a relationship with Jesus. The curriculum must provide for growth in the knowledge of God's Word and the motivation to live God's Word.

3. **Discussion Driven**

There are many legitimate ways in which people learn and grow in their faith. One distinctive of Link Groups, however, is growth through group interaction. Groups are not allowed to use resources that keep people from discussion and sharing. One example of a curriculum that would not be allowed would be one where a master-teacher does all of the talking. This applies to live teachers as well as teachers on video.
